## OFFER DESCRIPTION

The Post-Doctoral researcher should develop tasks in the context of the “Revisões literárias: a aplicação criativa de romances velhos (sécs. XV-XVII)” research project, which is focussed on the functional presence of verses from ballads in other literary genres. The researcher should a) expand the references of the old bibliography of the music of the old ballads cataloged in the RELIT-Rom database, <https://relitrom.pt/> (bibliographic list to be provided by the person in charge of the Project); b) develop the study of the music of the ballads inventoried in the database from the specialized musical bibliography; c) collaborate in the design and development of the RELIT-Rom database structure with a view to integrating musical and musicological contents; d) fill in the fields dedicated to musical and musicological content; e) collaborate in the Project's annual Seminar, presenting a communication; f) submit a study on the subject of the Scholarship program in a reference journal.

Duration of the fellowship: the fellowship will last for 4 months, starting in June 2022. The fellowship contract may be renewable.

Researcher Profiles: Post-Doctoral Researcher in the field of Musical Sciences, Historical Musicology or equivalent and interest in the intersections of ancient music and poetry / Researchers applying to this post must have obtained a Phd degree within the last 3 years.

Research fields: Musical Sciences, Historical Musicology or equivalent.

However, it is mandatory to present the acknowledgement up to the moment of contracting the scholarship.

## Benefits

Amount of monthly maintenance allowance: the amount of the scholarship corresponds to € 1,686, according to the table of values of scholarships awarded directly by FCT, I.P. in Portugal (<http://www.fct.pt/apoios/bolsas/valores>). To this amount is added the voluntary social insurance corresponding to the first level, in case the candidate opts for its attribution, as well as the personal accident insurance.

## Eligibility criteria

PhD obtained in the field of Musical Sciences, Historical Musicology or equivalent, less than 3 years ago, in a different host institution than IELT. Demonstrable experience or interest in Early Music and the intersections of music and poetry. Basic digital skills. Ability to integrate multidisciplinary teams.

In compliance with article 7 of the FCT Research Grants Regulations (Reg. no. 950/2019), the candidate(s) must:

- a) hold a doctoral degree obtained within the three years prior to the date of submission of the application for the grant;
- b) have developed the research work that led to the award of the degree of doctoral degree in an entity other than the entity receiving the grant
- c) Not exceed, with the conclusion of the scholarship contract in question, including possible renewals, an accumulated period of three c) Does not exceed, with the signing of the grant contract in question, including possible renewals, an accumulated period of three years in this type of grant, consecutive or interpolated
- d) Not to have had a previous post-doctoral research fellowship contract with FCSH.

Academic degrees obtained in foreign countries need to be registered by a Portuguese institution, in accordance Portuguese institution, according to Decree Law no. 66/2018, of August 16th and Administrative Rule no. 33/2019, of January 25th.
