## OFFER DESCRIPTION

The Post-Doctoral researcher should develop tasks in the context of the Arquivo do Romancero em Português ([www.romanceiro.pt](http://www.romanceiro.pt)) research project, which develops a research infrastructure towards the Portuguese expression folk balladry. The researcher should: a) carry the current maintenance tasks to be performed in the database of the "Arquivo do Romancero em Português" (Romanceiro.pt) in a joint effort with the archive coordination; b) perform the OCR of poetic texts in .pdf format, their revision and the uploading of the resulting transcriptions into the archive database, under the scientific supervision of the project's coordination and in cooperation with other PhD members of the team; c) work on the updating of the Portuguese corpus of the archive, through the input of new textual and sound records (mainly from 2008 on) in cooperation with the coordination of the platform; d) curate virtual exhibitions of Portuguese language folk ballads to be implemented in the archive's Omeka infrastructure; e) deliver a paper at an international congress and to submit a theoretical-practical scientific paper on the research that may contribute to the improvement of the state-of-the-art in the field of research.

Duration of the fellowship: the fellowship will last for 4 months, starting in June 2022. The fellowship contract may be renewable.

Post-doctoral researcher in the field of Literary Studies, with skills in the usage of digital collaborative platforms and the ability to integrate multidisciplinary teams. Researchers applying to this post must have obtained a PhD degree within the last 3 years.

Research fields: Literary Studies (Folk Literature Studies) or equivalent.

- In the case of academic degrees obtained in foreign higher education institutions, it is necessary to present the recognition of the degrees obtained, in accordance with DL No. 66/2018, of 16 August; or, in the absence of recognition at the time of candidacy, a declaration under an honorary commitment that this recognition will be made prior to contracting the Scholarship, in case of being the selected candidate. However, it is mandatory to present the acknowledgement up to the moment of contracting the scholarship.

## Benefits

Amount of monthly maintenance allowance: the amount of the scholarship corresponds to € 1,686, according to the table of values of scholarships awarded directly by FCT, I.P. in Portugal (<http://www.fct.pt/apoios/bolsas/valores>). To this amount is added the voluntary social insurance corresponding to the first level, in case the candidate opts for its attribution, as well as the personal accident insurance.

## Eligibility criteria

PhD in Portuguese Studies, Romance Studies, Editorial Studies and related; or in Digital Humanities or equivalent, less than 3 years ago, in a different host institution than IELT. Skills in the usage of digital collaborative platforms and the ability to integrate multidisciplinary teams. High skills on Portuguese language.

In compliance with article 7 of the FCT Research Grants Regulations (Reg. no. 950/2019), the candidate(s) must:

- a) hold a doctoral degree obtained within the three years prior to the date of submission of the application for the grant;
- b) have developed the research work that led to the award of the degree of doctoral degree in an entity other than the entity receiving the grant
- c) Not exceed, with the conclusion of the scholarship contract in question, including possible renewals, an accumulated period of three c) Does not exceed, with the signing of the grant contract in question, including possible renewals, an accumulated period of three years in this type of grant, consecutive or interpolated
- d) Not to have had a previous post-doctoral research fellowship contract with FCSH.

Academic degrees obtained in foreign countries need to be registered by a Portuguese institution, in accordance Portuguese institution, according to Decree Law no. 66/2018, of August 16th and Administrative Rule no. 33/2019, of January 25th.
